Now is a great time to start or renew your Lehigh Valley Zoo membership— because as of August 1, 2016 ALL memberships will have a necessary price increase. *Join or Renew now to save!* New pricing for memberships is as follows:

- Individual Membership (currently \$60) will increase to \$65
  NEW Couples \$85 (no children)
  Family Membership (currently \$105) will increase to \$125 (2 adults and 4 children, any additional children \$10 per child)
  Grandparents Membership (currently \$85) will increase to \$100 (2 adults and 5 grandchildren, any additional grandchild \$10 per child)
  Zookeeper Club (currently \$105) will increase to \$205 (3 adults and 4 children, any additional children \$10 per child)
  Presidential Circle will remain at \$500


# **Zoo News**

The Zoo's full-circle conservation projects spotlight the Eastern Spadefoot Toad and Spotted Turtle (local), Mexican Gray Wolf (national), and African Penguin (international).
